In addition, businesses must not have received an incentive from SoCalGas for the same equipment within the past five years, and all projects and equipment must meet the Program's Basic Requirements (listed on page 2).

<b>FAUCET AERATORS</b>		
<b>Faucet Aerators</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 0.5 GPM to 1 GPM flow rate</li> <li>• Private or public lavatory</li> </ul>	\$2.50-\$3.50 each

### Basic Requirements

- All equipment must be new natural gas-fired equipment. Fuel switching does not qualify.
- Qualifying equipment must be purchased and installed between June 7, 2021, and December 31, 2023. In addition, the purchase date of the equipment must be within the calendar year that the application is submitted unless indicated otherwise.
- All required efficiencies must exceed Title 20 and 24 standards.†
- Equipment must meet the Program's technical specifications. Your account manager will provide guidance on measure-specific information.

†Title 20 refers to Appliance Efficiency Regulations; Title 24 outlines Building Energy Efficiency Standards. Please visit the California Energy Commission at [energy.ca.gov](http://energy.ca.gov) for more information.
